

Alcohol Use Policy

BACKGROUND

All properties (property line to property line) and building Facilities of Alexandria Country Day School are owned by Alexandria Country Day School.

POLICY ON USE OF ALCOHOL WITHIN THE FACILITIES:

1. Specific Provisions.

- (a) Except as provided in subparagraph (b) below, only beer and wine and vinous liquor may be dispensed and consumed at an "adult only" event or activity that is permitted or approved under the Facilities Use Policy.
- (b) Unless approved by the Board of Trustees and Head of School, no alcoholic beverages may be used in connection with an event or activity at which persons in attendance are or are expected to be adults of legal age.

2. General Provisions.

- (a) For purposes of this policy, "alcoholic beverages," "distilled spirits," "beer," "wine and vinous liquor," and other terms will have the meanings given to them in the Louisiana Alcoholic Beverage Code, as amended from time to time (LAB Code). The terms "use" or "used" when utilized in connection with any alcoholic beverage will mean the dispensing, manufacture, sale, distribution, transportation, consumption or possession of any such alcoholic beverage.
- (b) No alcoholic beverages of any type may be used on or within the Facilities unless such use is in connection with an event or activity that is permitted or approved under the Facilities Use Policy.
- (c) All uses of alcoholic beverages on or within the Facilities must be permitted under the Louisiana Alcoholic Beverage Code.
- (d) Under no circumstances will alcoholic beverages be used by minors.

- (e) All events and activities at which alcoholic beverages are used must be conducted in accordance with the Policy on Security at Events. The security personnel and staff on duty in connection with such an event or activity are authorized by the School to monitor and enforce compliance with this policy to the extent permitted by law.
- (f) It is expected that any consumption of alcoholic beverages at any event or activity will be modest and consistent with social responsibility. Specific events or activities at which consumption is excessive may be terminated and/or specific persons whose consumption is excessive may be asked to leave the Facilities using a taxi.
